**UFBU CALL FOR 2 DAYS STRIKE ON 20<sup>TH</sup> & 21<sup>ST</sup> FEB, 2013**  
**CAMPAIGN AGAINST ANTI-PEOPLE POLICIES OF THE GOVT**

We invite the attention of our members to the first ever 48 hours general strike call given by the Central Trade Unions in the country as a part of massive campaign against UPA Govt's anti-people policies. UFBU has joined the campaign by calling for 2 days bank strike on 20 and 21 of Feb 2013 and demanded inter alia immediate settlement of pending issues and wage revision. It is estimated that nearly 20 crore workers including farm labour are likely to join the strike. A detailed circular issued by AIBPARC in this connection is annexed herewith for your information. We call upon all our members and functionaries to take part in the demonstrations, rallies and meetings arranged by UFBU/AIBOC/AINBOF units in this connection in their respective areas and express our solidarity.

**Extract of Circular No.2/13 of AIBPARC dated 1<sup>th</sup> February, 2013.**

**Sub : Two days All India strike call given by the Joint National Convention of Trade Unions comprising of BMS, INTUC, AITUC, HMS, CITU, IUTUC, TUCC, UTUC, AICCTU and several other organisations.**

**Sub : AIBOC call for participation.**

You are all aware by this time that all the central trade unions of the country have given call for countrywide general strike on February 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>, 2013 for pressing the following demands :

1. Concrete measure to contain price-rise,
2. Strict enforcement of labour laws,
3. Universal social security cover for organised and unorganized workers.
4. Stoppage of disinvestment in central and state P.S. undertakings.
5. No contractisation of work which are of permanent and perennial nature etc.
6. Fixation of statutory minimum wages at not less than Rs.10000/- linked with cost price index.
7. Removal of all ceiling on payment and eligibility of Bonus.
8. Assured pension for all.
9. Registration of trade unions within 45 days.
10. Immediate ratification of the recommendation of ILO convention 87 & 98.
11. Generation of employment.

Comrades, you are all aware that all the major components UFBU have already supported the issues and decided to join the strike actions. A few other units of UFBU are to announce their decisions within a day or two. As AIBOC is a participant in the strike action for two days, we call upon all our leaders, activists, veterans and members to plunge into action. They are advised to maintain close links with the affiliates of AIBOC at respective bank level and offer all possible help to them by ensuring presence in rallies, demonstrations and also in joining the assembly before banks/offices on the days of strike.
