## SEVENTH MEETING OF CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF SBPRA HELD AT KOLKATTA ON 17<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2015

A meeting of Central Committee of SBPRA the 7<sup>th</sup> in a row was held at Kolkatta on 17<sup>th</sup> Nov 2015. The meeting was convened in such a way as to coincide with the Central Conference of All India Bank Pensioners and Retirees Confederation (AIBPARC) to enable all our CC members to take part in the said conference. The Conference of the Confederation held on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Nov was a grand success, the report about which has been brought to you separately vide our Cir No. 17 of 2015. The Central Committee meeting was held on the following day ie 17<sup>th</sup> Nov at Hotel Swagat, Hazra Road Kolkatta. Com. Swapan Mitra, Zonal Secretary, Com. Tapan Mukherjee, Regional Secretary and their team had made elaborate arrangements during three days stay of the CC members.

Com. R K Sharma President chaired the CC meeting. We are happy to inform that for the first time SBOA was represented at the meeting both by the President and General Secretary viz Com. Prakash Karotya and Com. S A Manjrekar respectively. The house at the outset appreciated the presence of both the principal office-bearers of SBOA by a standing ovation. In his opening remarks Com. RK Sharma summarised the proceedings of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Joint Meeting held with the management on 28.9.2015. He appreciated the growth of Association with membership crossing 5800 mark.

The General Secretary Com. C Gangadhar Yadav placed before the house the activities of the organisation during the period under review. While speaking on the outcome of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Joint Meeting he informed the house that there is still a need for lot of persuasion to clinch the agreed items. He appreciated the role played by Com. K Suresh Babu, Secretary in convincing the new incumbent General Manager (P) about many of our issues/demands during negotiations. He thanked Com. Manjrekar, GS, SBOA for getting the meeting materialised. He also thanked Com. Dinker S Punja, Chairman, in absentia as the latter could not attend the CC meeting owing to prior domestic commitments, for his efforts in making the said meeting fruitful. Text of the Minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Joint Meeting was already circulated to the members. The General Secretary congratulated Delhi Zone for mobilising highest membership ie over 1100 mark in the zone and topping the list of all ten zones. He appreciated and thanked Com. Prakash Karotya for his whole hearted support to SBPRA in this context. Thereafter he touched upon the organizational matters, industry level issues, AIBPARC triennial conference, CBPRO formation and bank level pending matters. He stressed the need for implementing action programs given by AIBPARC/CBPRO in the course of pursuit of retirees' issues especially ensuring success of proposed dharna at Jantar Mantar New Delhi on 11.12.2015.

Speaking on the occasion Com SA Manjrekar explained about the efforts being made to ensure cooperation of bank management in settling the retirees' issues. He also elaborated the steps taken to ensure restoration of domiciliary treatment charges reimbursement under the IBA formulated Medical Insurance Scheme. Com. Prakash Karotya assured the house about the continued support of SBOA in all endeavours. Later there was a detailed reporting by zones about the activities and thorough discussion on all issues of members interests. Then financial statements and accounts were placed before the house and approved.
